[This is the latest in a series of procedural updates. These updates deal with specific MVD procedures and practices. Managers and Supervisors should consistently distribute the updates to all personnel and integrate them into regular information and training sessions.]

Effective Monday, September 14, there is no longer a "X" selection in the fuel field of MVD 2.0. The code that should be used for all hybrid gas (or other fuel) and electric vehicles is "B."

Previously the existence of two different codes ("B" and "X") that both appeared to apply to hybrid vehicles has caused some confusion.

Accordingly, the "X" option (VEH-FUEL-GAS-N-ELECTRIC) has been eliminated and all vehicles that were previously coded as "X" have been recoded as "B" (VEH-FUEL-HYBRID-ELEC).

All hybrid vehicles (vehicles that are powered by a combination of electric and gas or other fuel) should be coded "B."
