The Cumbres & Toltec Railway plate is now available for order using the new Application for Cumbres & Toltec Railway Plate (MVD-11309).

Effective immediately, the new Cumbres & Toltec Railway special license plate is available for order by customers using the new Application for Cumbres & Toltec Railway Plate (MVD-11309).



The Application for Cumbres and Toltec Plate (MVD-11309) is available on MVD's Internet forms page at http://www.tax.state.nm.us/forms/mvd/mvd_form.htm. It is also on the MVD intranet forms page. As with our other special plates, a customer who fills out the application form and returns it with a check or money order for \$42.00 will receive the plate in the mail.

\$25.00 of the \$42.00 fee collected (initially and on each registration renewal) for the Cumbres & Toltec Railway special plate will be distributed to the Cumbres and Toltec Scenic Railroad Commission.
